When you want to see a doctor or mental health professional from the comfort of home, LiveHealth Online is here for you. As one of your benefits with Anthem Blue Cross and Blue Shield (Anthem), this service helps you access care using your smartphone, tablet, or computer with a camera.

### With LiveHealth Online, you can have a virtual visit with a:



### Doctor, 24/7

You don't need an appointment and can usually be seen within 10 minutes for nonemergency issues, such as cold or flu symptoms, allergies and sinus infections, pink eye, and rashes. The doctor can go over your health, provide treatment options, and even send a prescription to your pharmacy, if needed.<sup>12</sup>



### Board-certified psychiatrist, usually within 14 days

A psychiatrist can evaluate your condition and provide medication management support, but does not offer talk therapy.<sup>1,3</sup>



# Psychologist or licensed therapist, usually within a few days

You can talk face-to-face about mental health concerns, such as depression, stress, anxiety, and coping with illness. Medication can't be prescribed.<sup>1,4</sup>



# Board-certified dermatologist, 24/7

Connect with a dermatologist for consultations, diagnosis, and treatment plans, including prescriptions sent to your pharmacy, if needed.







### Frequently asked questions about LiveHealth Online

### How do I pay for an online visit?

LiveHealth Online accepts Visa, Mastercard®, Discover, and American Express cards.

Charges for prescriptions aren't included in the cost of your visit.

# Can LiveHealth Online provide a doctor's note for work or school?

**Yes.** During your video visit, tell your doctor you need a sick slip. The slip will include the date of the visit, a recommended date of return for work or school, and any activity restrictions.

### To keep a copy:

- 1. Log in from your device.
- 2. Select your inbox (the envelope icon).
- 3. Choose the notification email associated with the visit.
- 4. View the slip as a PDF or Word file under Attachments.

You can't access sick slips through the LiveHealth Online app.

# How do I schedule a LiveHealth Online appointment with a mental health professional?

- 1. Download the no-added-cost LiveHealth Online app or visit **livehealthonline.com** to sign up or log in.
- 2. Choose LiveHealth Online Psychiatry or LiveHealth Online Psychology.
- 3. Select who you would like to see by reviewing each care provider's educational background and area of focus.
- 4. Choose a day and time that works best for your schedule.
- 5. You can also make an appointment by calling 888-548-3432.

# How do I decide which mental health professional to see?

- Log in to the app or livehealthonline.com and select LiveHealth Online Psychiatry or LiveHealth Online Psychology.
- 2. View profiles of available psychiatrists, psychologists, and therapists.
- 3. Once you find the best match, schedule a visit.
- 4. At the end of your first visit, you can set up future appointments with the same care provider or search for a new one.

### What else do I need to know about LiveHealth Online Psychiatry and LiveHealth Online Psychology?

- You must be at least 18 years old to see a psychiatrist online.
- Children ages 10 to 17 can see a psychologist or therapist online but must be added to a parent's or guardian's LiveHealth Online account first.
- You'll receive an appointment reminder email 15 minutes before your scheduled time.
