LiveHealth Online connects you to doctors and other care providers who can:


- Review your health history (if you allow access).
- Assess your symptoms.
- Recommend testing or provide a treatment plan for common health conditions such as eye and ear infections, colds, the flu, and sinus and allergy problems.
- Prescribe basic medications, when needed.*

Your visit and health information will always be kept confidential and secure.

Register now for faster care later

Sign up for LiveHealth Online when it's convenient for you, so you can connect to care more quickly when you need it. Each member over 18 is required to have their own account.

- Download the free app from the <u>App Store®</u> or <u>Google Play™</u> or visit <u>livehealthonline.com</u>.
- 2. Choose Sign up.
- Create an account by following the directions and using the member ID number exactly as it appears on your Anthem card. When asked, choose Anthem Blue Cross and Blue Shield.





How to visit with a care provider at LiveHealth Online

After creating an account, it takes just minutes to connect with a care provider whenever you need nonurgent advice or care.

- 1. Go to the LiveHealth Online app or <u>livehealthonline.com</u> and choose Log in.
- Select Set Up New Visit. Answer questions including
 who the visit is for (such as yourself or a child), and the
 reason for the visit. You will also be asked to make sure
 your address, medical history, allergies, insurance, and
 pharmacy information is correct.
- Select LiveHealth Online Urgent Care, Therapy, or Psychiatry to choose a care provider or to start an urgent care visit.
- 4. Pay your copay or your percentage of the cost with a credit or debit card.
- 5. Visit with a doctor who will provide a treatment plan and submit a prescription, if needed, to the pharmacy you choose.

A summary of your visit will be stored in your personal LiveHealth Online account. A claim for the visit will automatically be sent to Anthem.
